## **Melodic Dictations**

## **Assignment:**

Re-create what you hear in Melody Dictations files 1–4 by recording it in the software.

- 1. "Mary Had a Little Lamb" (start on E).
- 2. "Twinkle, Twinkle" (start on C).
- 3. "Brother John" ("Frère Jacques") (start on C).
- 4. "Yankee Doodle" (start on C).

## **Procedure:**

- 1. Open the Melodic Dictations audio file 1 in a playback software program (iTunes, Real Player, etc.) or the operating system, or import the audio track into the software.
- 2. Open a new file: File > New.
- 3. Name the file "Melodies \_ \_ " (your initials).
- 4. Add a software instrument track and choose a flute or violin as the instrument. Set the metronome to 85.
- 5. Listen to the first piece and figure out how to play it on the piano keyboard.
- 6. You do not need to memorize the entire melody. You can play a measure or two at a time and then record more.
- 7. You *must* record as close to the click as possible.
- 8. Do not cut and paste. Record in "real time."
- 9. Quantize before you record anything else.
- 10. When you are finished recording the first melody, either skip a measure and record the second melody or add a track and record the second melody on a new track.
- 11. Quantize each melody.
- 12. Record all four melodies.
